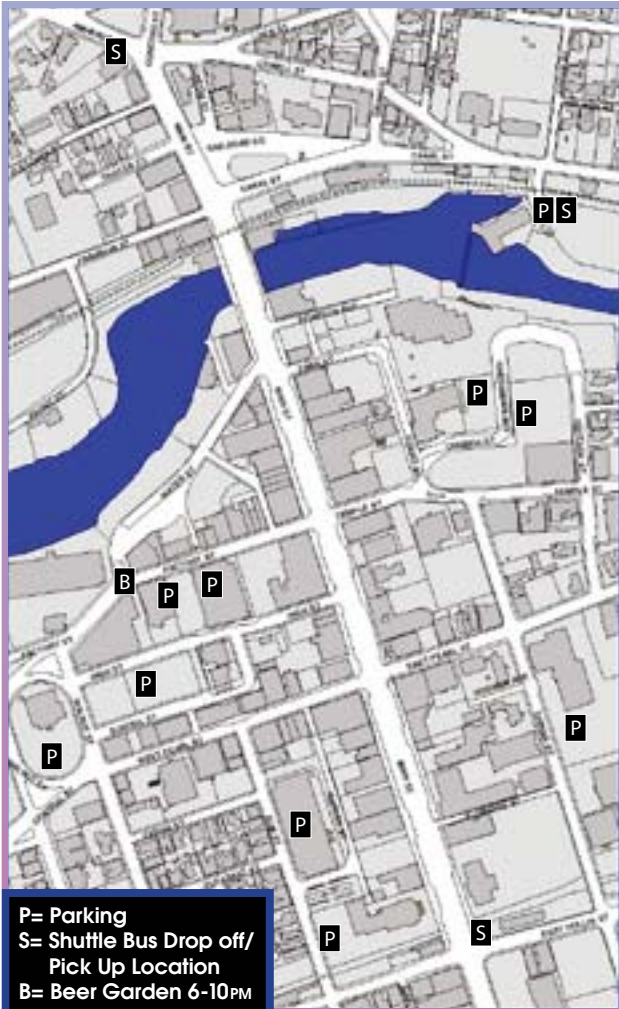


Map
